

## The Law and Off Roading.

By Statute. "A person Shall not be guilty of an offence under section 1,2 and 3 (dangerous, careless and inconsiderate driving) of this Act by virtue of driving a mechanically propelled vehicle in a public place other than a road if he shows that he was driving in accordance with an authorisation for a motoring event given under regulations made by the Secretary of State (Statutory Instrument No 1370)"

The IOPD along with 10 others are empowered by the Secretary of State under Statuary Instrument 1371 and recognised as one of the eleven Authorising Bodies under Statutory Instrument 1370 of the Road Traffic Act Regulations 1002 and 1995.

The bodies are: Amateur Motor Cycle Association Ltd, Association of Land Rover Clubs Ltd, The Auto – Club Union, The British Schoolboy Motorcycle Association, The International Organisation of Professional Drovers Ltd, The National Autograss Sport Association Ltd, NORA 92 Ltd, National Traction Engine Trust, The Royal Automobile Club, Scottish Auto Cycle Union Ltd, Youth Motorcycle Sport Association Ltd.

Conclusion: When ever and were ever off roading make sure there is a permit issued by one of the above association authorising that event. Some organised 'Play Days' may not have a permit, so check first and ask to see their permit.
