Green Lanes

As I'm sure your all aware, many of the byways of Northants, Beds and Cambs are only available to use between May and October of each year, and the drier weather we have been experiencing has been an idea time to get out and enjoy these amenities.

Please remember to treat the lanes with respect and only go in small groups and in conditions unlikely to cause damage to the surface. The GLASS code of conduct gives useful guidance. If your new to laning and unsure where to go, have a chat with any of the committee and they should be able to point you in the right direction. On a recent jaunt, we noted temporary TRO's closing the following lanes;

- The byway from Grafham Water towards Easton (Cambs)
- The block of byways between villages of Swineshead, Tillbrook and Lower Dean (Beds and Cambs)

Please contact the Local Authority for full details of these closures.

We also noted that vegetation in some areas is encroaching heavily onto the lanes, and care will be required in your choice of lanes if you have any shiny motors. Again it can be useful to chat to other club members to find out the latest information.
