# Important Notice to all club members

Dear Members,

Just a quick reminder that YOU, our members, are our 'shop window' to the world and whether it is when laning, trialling or at shows your conduct will influence people's image of the club. This can make the difference between other local owners considering joining ENLROC or crossing the road to avoid us. Within the club we try not to be too prescriptive with rules as the world has enough of them already, however at events etc please respect your fellow members and consider whether your actions could be upsetting or antisocial to others.

It is worth remembering that we are a car club and our Land Rovers are a key part of what we are. They are however a very big and heavy object and should be treated with respect especially where other people are around. Please therefore take care when moving vehicles around and follow all relevant show/trial/highway rules. In particular please think about the following;

- Please keep your speed appropriate for your event – remember for most off road driving it's still 'as slow as possible – as fast as necessary' and when laning the code of conduct recommends travelling at no more than 12mph on unsurfaced RoW, most shows have a blanket speed of 5 or 10mph.
- When manoeuvring in busy or constrained areas such as shows and especially when moving caravans/trailers or positioning vehicles on ramps etc please ensure spectators are out of any danger zone and consider asking someone to watch/guide you.
- When moving vehicles please ensure passengers are in safe and appropriate places, whilst it might seem like fun, the roof rack, trailer or front wing are not really suitable.
- Please enjoy alcohol responsibly, whilst it is an integral part of many people's social life please do not move your vehicle whilst under the influence (other members may be happy to move it for you) and as a family club please ensure your intake doesn't spoil another families enjoyment.
- If you wish to let children play in your motor, please ensure it is safely parked and the keys are removed, you might also consider chocking a wheel.
- If you have to leave an animal in a vehicle, please consider the weather and ensure your pet's welfare is looked after.

Above all everyone is out to have a relaxed and enjoyable time, I for one would hate for anyone – adult or child - to be hurt at a club event. We want ENLROC to continue to be a fun and friendly place for all, and as a small club we need to do all we can to attract new members and keep those we have. If you want to discuss any of the above points or have any concerns or ideas please do not hesitate to speak to me or any of the other committee members.
